



The GOOD WOOD *List*

Below is the list of wood species we believe are appropriate for constructing wood windows and doors which will be exposed to weather. They are listed in descending order of preference:

- Teak (*Tectona grandis*)
 - Honduras mahogany (*Swietenia macrophylla*)
 - Douglas fir (*Pseudotsuga menziesii*)
 - African mahogany (*Khaya nyassica*)

We are happy to consider suggestions of other species but we will require several weeks for assessment.

Wood windows require a finish to protect them from the elements and deliver a long service life. Weiland does not perform wood finishing; therefore the purchaser is responsible for selecting, applying and maintaining an appropriate finish. Many variables affect how long a finish will last. In some cases, like an oceanfront, eastern or southern exposure, finish maintenance may need to be performed several times a year. This is the homeowners' responsibility and Weiland will not warranty products which have not been properly maintained.

Please remember that most woods are available on the interior of the aluminum wood products. In addition, Weiland is willing to split species on our wood products in order to provide a product that weathers well and matches our customers' interior choice of wood.
